- FROM THE SOUTH: Take I65 N to Exit 59A. Merge onto TN-840 E via EXIT 59A toward Knoxville / Murfreesboro. Take the Sulphur Springs Rd exit, EXIT 57. Keep right at the fork to go on Sulphur Springs Rd. Turn left onto Leanna Rd (Leanna Rd is 0.1 miles past Timberlake Dr If you reach Shacklett Rd you've gone about 0.8 miles too far). Turn right to stay on Leanna Rd (Leanna Rd is 0.6 miles past Jamestown St. If you are on Leanna Swamp Rd and reach Andrew Jackson Blvd you've gone about 1.0 mile too far). Take the 1st left onto Cherry Ln (If you reach Allen Rd you've gone about 0.1 miles too far). 1047 CHERRY LN is on the right.
- FROM THE NORTH: Take I24E toward Chattanooga to TN -840 E. Merge onto TN-840 E via EXIT 74B toward Lebanon / Knoxville. Take the Sulphur Springs Rd exit, EXIT 57. Follow directions above.

Fast CAT is open to all dogs 12 months of age or older that are individually registered/listed with the AKC registration as purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS) dogs, Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) dogs and AKC Canine.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

FAST CAT TESTS ROLL CALL

Roll call is the time when participants are expected to check-in by. check-in is followed by inspection for fitness, lameness or "in season" females

TEST HOURS: 8:00 am CST until completed.

MORNING ROLL CALL: 7:30 am for all Breeds

AFTERNOON ROLL CALL: 30 MINUTES AFTER MORNING TEST HAS BEEN COMPLETED

You will be expected to have complete info for your dog.
Incomplete entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY MAIL OR E-MAIL

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = every additional 500 points.

Top 20 by Breed by Year: The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed.

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK

- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the “Agreement” found on the Official AKC Entry Form
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entries will be refunded
- Mixed breeds must be spayed or neutered to be eligible to run. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog’s physical strength.
- Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog’s entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded
- **A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress**
- Battery powered, continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic bags
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Persons who exhibit conduct detrimental to the AKC/TKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- Bring your own shade and water
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.

- Bring your own food, water and shade. No littering. Pick up after your dogs. There will be a \$5.00 fine for NOT cleaning up after your hounds. There will be a \$5.00 fine for any dogs off lead on the trial grounds ~ including after the trial.
- All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals attending these shows grant the club the right to use their likeness and voice in any matter without further consent.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any and each loose dog(s) not competing in the course in progress.
- A return check fee of \$15.00 will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.

The FAST CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards where a dog chases a lure. Dogs are run singularly and earn points based on their handicapped speed. There are no placements. Titles are issued at designated benchmarks. The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into MPH. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap

100 YARD DASH TIME CONVERTED TO MILES PER HOUR

A dog's 100-yard dash time must be converted into MPH using the formula below, rounded to the nearest hundredth of a mile:

$$\frac{204.545}{\text{Dog's time}} = \text{MPH}$$

Example: The dog's time is 8.14 seconds
 $204.54 / 8.14 = 25.13$ MPH

The Start: Dogs may start up to 10 feet behind the starting line.

The Finish: The club will provide a safe run-out area, with a minimum of 30 yards. The owner or someone familiar with the dog should stand at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed.

TIPS FOR HANDLERS

1. The field is fenced. However, it is strongly recommended that prior to running your dog, you have good "recall" control over your dog, as the dogs will be off leash.
2. Handlers should wear comfortable, sturdy shoes (no sandals or flip flops, please!) and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them.
3. Handlers may carry toys or treats on their persons to assist with retrieving their dog at the completion of their run.
4. Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released only upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the Huntmaster. Dogs may be released by hand, folded leash or using a traditional lure coursing slip lead,
5. The Huntmaster will instruct the handler to "Retrieve your dog" upon completion of the run. The handler is expected to promptly secure the dog and leave the field with the dog on leash.
6. Handlers are advised to warm up their dogs prior to their run and walk them for about 10 minutes afterwards.
7. Lure coursing is a physically demanding sport so please make sure your dog is in good shape. If you are not sure, make an appointment with a veterinarian to get an opinion.
8. Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the test by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under control of their parents or guardian(s) at all times
