Ward's accomplishments are numerous:

Over 250 HIT, 60+ perfect 200's – a record in the history of Canadian Obedience Trialing.

Ward's success in competition obedience over the past twelve years has lead to his being recognized as one of the top obedience trainers and competitors in North America.

In 1999, Dogs in Canada Magazine ranked Ward and his Shetland Sheepdog OTCh, GMOTCh Simaril Slater as the #1 obedience team in Canada. This placement was followed by five consecutive years of placing in the Top Ten All-Breeds obedience dogs in Canada.

In 2008, Dogs in Canada Magazine again ranked Ward and his dog, this time Golden Retriever NOC, CTCh, GMOTCh Spirit's Zim Zam Zoom UDX6, OM5, as the #1 obedience team in Canada. With Zoom, Ward has established a number of Canadian obedience records which culminated in winning the AKC/Eukanuba National Obedience Invitational in the United States. As a result, Zoom is recognized as the 2011 National Obedience Champion.

Seminar Content

Advanced Obedience Focusing on Accuracy, Speed, Style and Endurance – mainly at the Open and Utility levels.

This seminar focuses on how to train your dog and build a team to compete at the highest level of competition obedience. Development of this type of seminar was initially prompted by a quote made by Petra Ford (twice winner of the NOI and winner of the Crufts World Cup) when she referred to Zoom and I as "...an absolutely amazing team. Insanely accurate while maintaining SPEED and Style! Everyone should be striving for accuracy."

Competitors have often approached me and asked, "How do you train to get such incredible accuracy," or "How do you train to get the attitude and endurance shown by Zoom?"

This type of seminar is designed to answer these questions. The second day is conducted as a problem – solving workshop.

Driving Directions to Nashville Dog Training Club

From I-440

- Take Nolensville Rd exit headed south. Go 2 miles.
- Turn right onto Allied Drive (at Whitt's Barbeque).
- Immediately turn left into the first row of warehouses.

From I-65

- Take the Harding Place exit headed east.
- Turn left at the traffic light onto Trousdale (gas station on your left). Go through the light and over the railroad tracks.
- At the stop sign, turn right onto Allied Drive.
- Go to the last row of warehouses on the right before you get to Nolensville Rd.

From I-24

- Take Briley Parkway West exit (Thompson Lane)
- Turn left at Nolensville Road.
- Turn right onto Allied Drive (at Whitt's Barbeque).
- Immediately turn left into the first row of warehouses.
