Refunds

- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund will be made. The club may cancel the events due to extreme weather conditions.
- "No entry fee may be returned after entries close, except that of a bitch that comes in season after being entered or an injured dog. A refund less a \$5.00 fee per entry to cover expenses will only be issued if the Trial Secretary receives a Veterinarian's Certificate to this effect at least ½ hour prior to the start of classes.
- No refunds for overpayment of fees will be made for amounts less than \$5.

Directions

From I-440

- Take Nolensville Rd exit headed south. Go 2 miles.

- · Take the Harding Place exit headed east.
- Turn left at the traffic light onto Trousdale (gas station on your left). Go through the light and over the railroad tracks.
- At the stop sign, turn right onto Allied Drive.
- Go to the last row of warehouses on the right before you get to Nolensville Rd.

From I-24

- Take Briley Parkway West exit (Thompson Lane)
- Turn left at Nolensville Road.

- " It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Dachshunds (Inaboth most), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. [Event Class] Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
